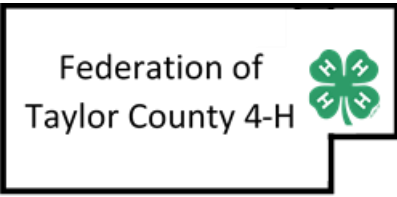

Financial Obligations

The family of the youth will write two separate checks for the educational experience.

One check in the amount of ½ of the cost and the other in the amount of ½ of the cost. One of the checks will be deposited before the educational experience. In the event that the youth is unable to attend* or there are behavior issues while attending the educational experience, the other ½ check will be deposited. If there are no behavior issues and the youth attends the educational experience, the remaining ½ check will be destroyed after the experience.

Please have both the ½ checks to the Extension office no earlier than 3 weeks before the educational experience.
