 - B. Projects (0-10 points)
 - C. Participation in 4-H leadership activities, service projects. (0-30 points)
 - D. Essay (0-30 points)
- 5. Applications must be completed using the fillable .pdf file available on the Extension Taylor County 4-H website or typed on the form provided.
- 6. Applications must be submitted to the Extension Taylor County office (address below) and received no later than April 1, 4:30 p.m.
- 7. Each application must have two letters of recommendation: one from a 4-H leader and one from a person of their choice. Recommendations cannot be written by family members. Letters of Recommendation can be attached to the application or sent directly to the address below. They must be received by April 1.
